

## The End Times Is upon Us

But take heed to yourselves and be on your guard, said YAHSHUA, lest your hearts be overburdened and depressed with the giddiness and headache and nausea of self-indulgence, drunkenness, and worldly worries and cares pertaining to this life, and that day come upon you suddenly like a trap or a noose; keep awake then and watch at all times, praying that you may have the full strength and ability and **be accounted worthy to escape all these things that will take place, and to stand in the presence of the Son of Man (Luke 21:34,36).**

We believe, without a doubt, that we are experiencing the end of days, "As it were in the days of Noah". YAHSHUA warned us by saying, As were the days of Noah, so will be the coming of the Son of Man. For just as in those days before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and being given in marriage, until the day when Noah went into the ark; and they did not know or understand until the flood came and swept them all away- so will be the coming of the Son of Man (Matt. 24: 37-29). In Noah's day the earth was depraved and putrid in God's sight, and the land was filled with violence; God looked upon the world and saw how degenerate, debased, and vicious it was, for all humanity had corrupted their way upon the earth and lost their true direction. The Lord saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination and intention of all human thinking was only evil continually. God said to Noah, I intend to make an end of all flesh, for through men the land is filled with violence; and behold, I will destroy them and the land (Gen.6:2,5; 6:11-13). Our God is looking upon this earth again to bring destruction, for the evil of Noah's day are upon us, and many are not aware of the coming destruction, although God has warned us through His Word. Many people live shelled in their world of electronics aloof of what is happening around them. They don't want to hear to perceive and understand the truth. They will be caught by surprise, as were those people in Noah's day, when they were swept away by the flood.

Much suffering is predicted by our Lord YAHSHUA for these last days. We see it and many feel it. Cries are going up to Him from many of us, although we have not seen anything yet. Today many are dying as martyrs for their faith in Christ, as it has always been. YAHSHUA warned us to be on our guard so we will not fall into worries pertaining to life, causing us to failing faith. The apostles also warned us of the spiritual condition of the last days. Paul said that in the last days perilous times shall come of great stress and trouble; **for people will be lovers of self and self-centered; lovers of money and aroused by an inordinate desire for wealth, proud and arrogant and contemptuous boasters, they will be abusive, disobedient to parents, ungrateful, unholy and profane, they will be without natural affection, relentless, slanderers intemperate and loose in morals and conduct uncontrolled and fierce, haters of good; they will be treacherous, rash, inflated with self-conceit. They will be lovers of sensual pleasures and vain amusements more than and rather than lover of God (II Tim. 3: 1-4).** The word perilous means violence as there was in the days of Noah. In these last days the earth is full of violence, as we see and hear every day. We know we are living in the last days for the increasing apostasy of the Christian Church, or the great falling away from the truth. Today's church has embraced a variety of false doctrines, making it to be an ecumenical church. All religions lead to heaven so they think and blinded by their unfaithfulness and ignorance of

God's Word, they will perish. Paul predicted this to Timothy long time ago. He said, Some will turn away from the faith, giving attention to deluding and seducing spirits and doctrines that demons teach, through the hypocrisy and pretensions of liars whose consciences are seared (I Tim. 4:1-2). YAHSHUA asked the question, When the Son of Man comes, will He find faith on the earth (Luke 18:8)?

These are days which represent the days of Sodom and Gomorra, when men lived a life of sexual misrepresentation of what God intended for mankind when He created "man and woman". Man's degrading passions for another man and woman for another woman, exchanging their natural function for unnatural and abnormal one, are abomination before the holy God, for it is a perversion of His plan. They will be victims of the judgment coming with the wrath of God falling upon them, as were those people from Sodom and Gomorra. The letter to the Romans chapter 1 verses 26-3, Paul describes homosexuality as unnatural and abnormal practices. Peter predicted that many will follow their immoral ways and lascivious doings; because of them the true Way will be maligned and defamed. Many churches today are maligning and defaming the Word of God with their depraved interpretation of the truth to accommodate and defend their immoral sexual practices. In Lot's day, when the two angels came to Sodom to bring destruction to it, Lot offered a place for them to stay. But the men of the city of Sodom, both young and old, and all the men from every quarter, surrounded the house, and they called to Lot and said, Where are the men who came to you tonight? Bring them out to us, that we may have sex with them (Gen. 19:1-5).

God (Who) did not even spare angels that sinned, but cast them into hell, delivering them to be kept there in pits of gloom till the judgment and their doom; and He spared not the ancient world, but preserved Noah, a preacher of righteousness, with seven other persons, when He brought a flood upon the world of ungodly; and He condemned to ruin and extinction the cities of Sodom and Gomorra, reducing them to ashes, set them forth as an example to those who would be ungodly; but He rescued righteous Lot, greatly worn out and distressed by the wanton ways of the ungodly and lawless; for that just man, living among them, tortured his righteous soul every day with what he saw and heard of [their] unlawful and wicked deeds ( II Peter 2:1-8). He will not spare today's world, which is reserved for destruction with fire, but He will deliver the righteous ones, as He did Noah and his family and Lot and his family.

We are witnessing a very intense spiritual darkness all over the world at this present time. All the cultic religions are standing strong and some of them with great violence against all those who do not follow their teachings. They are causing the earth to be full of violence; this is a fearful sign! The world is moving toward global government, as it is predicted in Daniel 2:40-44; 7:23; Rev. 13:7-8 global monetary systems and the coming of the antichrist. Israel's surrounding nations are uniting against her as it is prophesized in Psalms 83:4-8; Zech. 12:2. Russia as Magog, is in the path of rising as a military power leading nations to attack Israel, as it is predicted in Ezekiel 38. Violence and rumors of war are ever before our eyes! YAHSHUA said that nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom; there will be earthquakes in various places; there will be famines and calamities. This is but the beginning of the intolerable anguish and suffering (Mark 13:8).

We have been warned beforehand by the prophets of old, by YAHSHUA and His disciples. Nothing of what is happening should surprise us; but it should cause us to be ready, to look forward to the trumpet sounding, calling us up to meet YAHSHUA in the air, for He has not appointed us to [incur His] wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord YAHSHUA the Messiah (1 Thess. 5:9).
