

## Yahshua

Yahshua's life is the seed of eternal life that had to die in order for Him to see His spiritual offspring through His resurrection. He has become the source of eternal salvation through His death to whosoever will. Isaiah 53 says, He shall see the fruit of travail of His soul and be satisfied; He will justify making many righteous, for He has borne our iniquities and our guilt with consequences; the transgressors are now justified before His Father, He intercedes for them; and Paul says to the Ephesians, He has positioned them with Himself at the right hand of His Father.

With sacrifices of bulls for the atonement for sins He was not pleased; therefore God made ready a body for Him; in submission to the Father He said, Behold here I am, coming to do Your will, O God- to fulfill what is written of Me in the volume of the Book. So after He had offered a single sacrifice for our sins for all time, He sat down at the right hand of God (Heb. 10). By one single offering He has forever completely cleansed and perfected those who are consecrated and made holy. He assured that the forgiven sins He will remember no more. Therefore there is no longer any offering made to atone for sin; now with purified hearts and sprinkled from a guilty conscience, let's seize and hold fast and retain without wavering the hope we cherish and confess our acknowledgement of it; for He Who promised is reliable and faithful to His word (Heb. 10).

In His death, He carried our griefs (sicknesses, weaknesses and distresses), He carried our sorrows and pains. But in return man despised, rejected and forsook Him; they hid their faces from Him and did not value Him; His worth was trampled and they did not esteem Him; instead they considered Him to be punished by God, and so deserving of it. In their rejection of Him, men did not realize that it were his transgressions that were wounding Him; it was his guilt and iniquities that were bruising Him; it was his punishment He took upon Himself to bring him peace; all the stripes that wounded Him was for man's healing. His Father shone on Him our guilt and iniquity and considered Him the guilty one deserving of the cross in our instead. Yet we turned away from Him; we like sheep rejected His leading and followed our own way. But He took all upon Him as if He deserved, in submission without a word coming from His mouth; just like a lamb led to the slaughter. He was taken away by oppression and unjustly judged; He was cut off out the land of the living, He was stricken to His death- yes for the transgressions of us all. He was assigned with the wicked, as if He were one of them, although He was innocent and pure of all sins; He had done no violence, neither was any deceit in His mouth (Isaiah 53). How can we escape the eternal punishment, if we continue rejecting Him? The Word of God says, If we go on deliberately and willing sinning after once acquiring the knowledge of the Truth, there is no longer any sacrifice left to atone for sins; [there is nothing left for us then] but a kind of awful and fearful prospect and expectation of divine judgment and the fury of burning wrath and indignation which will consume those who put themselves in opposition [to God] (Heb. 10: 26, 27). The love of our YAHWEH extends to all men, apart from race and color. His love is unconditional and infinite; it is available at all times with opportunities for all to receive His Son. However, it will be the time when opportunity will close its doors if we continue rejecting such great love. God's love is so great, so sacrificial, that He was willing to sacrifice His

only Son to save mankind. His Son is the only way to His Father; He is the only truth; He is the only life available to all who will accept His love. He had to die to give us life eternal with Him. For God so loved the world in this way: He gave His One and Only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him will not perish but have everlasting life. For God did not send His Son into the world that He might condemn the world; but that the world might be saved through Him. Anyone who believes in Him is not condemned, but anyone who does not believe is already condemned, because he has not believed in the name of the One and Only Son of God (John 3:16-18).

It might be that any road will lead you to Rome; but not to heaven. There is no substitute road to heaven; there is no other truth apart from YAHSHUA'S; there is no other life guaranteed us, but the eternal life of YAHSHUA. When God's love was being poured through the blood of His Son while on cross, then reconciliation took place and forgiveness was applied to all who receive God's gift of salvation through His Son. So it was that while we were still sinners, He gave His life as ransom to free us from the power of sin and its consequences. That was the proof of God's love for the world. While men were ridiculing Him, He loved and saved them; His appearance was the picture of men's sinful state and condemnation; for that they rejected Him. Not realizing that they were as if looking at their condemned soul through a mirror.
